

In 1835, Reverend Marsh established Hill Street Academy in the back verandah of a church in Hulftsdorp with about 20 pupils. Moreover, she has become a beacon of unity and harmony as the country itself traversed some turbulent times. Much like yours in the East Coast of the US our association here in Melbourne has a rich history with a close-knit membership spanning all age groups who take a keen interest in our various events. As part of our service activities we continue to support underprivileged students at College through RCU's Loyalty Pledge program and by contributing to the medical fund of the Royal College Past Teachers Association. Like yours, our flagship event is the Annual Dinner Dance to be held in June this year. If any of your members plan on visiting Australia at that time please let us know; we will be more than happy to see them at our Dance.

I would like to congratulate the RCOBECF committee for organising this event, and wish everyone of you, members and guests, a great and memorable time tonight at the Dance. I hope that you will continue to support RCOBECF in their future endeavours, helping them reach even greater heights as an Association.

REMEMBERING OUR FIRST PRESIDENT DR. RANJIT KANISHKA PARAKRAMA ATAPATTU 1933 – 2018



We are deeply saddened by the recent passing of RCOBECA's First President – Dr. Ranjit Atapattu. Ranjit was born in Tangalla on 29th April 1933. His father D. P... Atapattu was a Member of Parliament for Tangalla from March 1960 to March 1970. Ranjit joined Royal College in 1945 from Royal Primary school. At Royal College he played rugger for the first fifteen and was scrum half at the Bradby shield match. From Royal he entered the Medical College and qualified as a doctor. After serving the government for a few years he set up a practice in Tangalla. He was known for his philanthropic qualities where he treated the less affluent patients free of charge.

In 1977 he became a Member of Parliament and continued until 1990 having held the positions of Minister for Colombo Group of hospitals and later Minster of Health. In 1991 Jim Grant the Executive Director of UNICEF offered a Director's post to Ranjit at UNICEF in New York and he moved to New York with his wife Dreda and his only child Druvi. Druvi entered Medical School and qualified as a doctor.

When the Royal College Old Boys' East coast Association (RCOBECA) was formed in 1993 the general membership unanimously decided to elect Ranjit as our first President. We had our first dinner dance at the Greek Orthodox Church hall in New Rochelle on the 12th of March 1994. In his message to the souvenir he mentioned that his hope was to have the dinner dance as an annual event and that the profits from the first dance should be used to give scholarships and accommodation grants to students entering Royal from rural areas. At the inaugural dance the band was all American and Ranjit sang a few bailas accompanied by Mithila with Anura Rajapaksa at the piano.

We can truly say that RCOBECA has made him proud by achieving his vision for the Association by celebrating its 25th Anniversary, and continuing to grow and enhance its charitable work.





The exceptional outcomes are a result of Dr. Harin's tremendous commitment and dedication to the NICU. He relentlessly strived for technical and procedural perfection. If you did not meet his expectations, he would let you know it. His loyal staff has been trained so well that even when he was not there, his wishes were always put into place. If you were not sure, you could call him up – day or night, weekday or weekend. Another great passion of Dr. Harin was teaching and guiding the Pediatric residents. For the last few years, he has served as the coordinator of the Pediatric Department's program to teach and promote professionalism among the trainees.

Whether a patient's family could not pay or whether they could donate to the hospital, Dr. Harin's children were always treated the same.

For almost three decades, Staten Islanders have been very lucky to have such a wonderful resource so close by. They have one special man to thank for that, Dr. Anantham Harin. In these times, it is rare and particularly noteworthy when one individual can truly make such a significant difference for so many. Dr. Harin has impacted the entire borough by creating a special unit where his presence can be felt day and night, all year long. While his friendship and his leadership will be missed, his legacy lives on in his many success stories.

When play was stopped due to bad light, the Royalists were on 143 runs for the loss of 6 wickets. The Dialog Trophy was shared by both teams while the D.S.Senanayake Shield was retained by Royal College.




