

Ladies & Gentlemen,

It gives me great pleasure to welcome every one of you to our 26<sup>th</sup> Annual Royal Ball. While this is a significant day for Royalists, we want the evening to be memorable for all our Guests who make this dance the successful event it is. We have enhanced the Event by having two live bands perform tonight. As proud members of the Royal College Old Boys' East Coast Foundation, we have been able to support our Alma Mater, as well as other charities in Sri Lanka and in the United States.

Your attending our Dance has enabled us to fund many essential academic and student enrichment programs that are not covered by government funding for our alma mater. These include setting up of new IT Labs, construction of new dormitories at the Royal College Hostel, renovation of classrooms, the Dental clinic, enhancing the Media unit. We have also provided assistance to sports projects such as Rowing, Rugby, Provisioning of IT textbooks to the students, setting up of Sports endowments. Funding has been made for new camping tents and multimedia projects for the Boy Scouts Troop. We have also contributed to the Welfare projects of past teachers and provisioning educational scholarships to needy students.

Additionally, funds raised through our annual Royal Ball dinner dance have also supported other charitable causes outside of Royal College, both here in the United States and in Sri Lanka. Donations have been made to those affected by hurricanes Harvey and Irma, and also reconstruction of damaged bridges in Ratnapura. Funding has been made for IT Labs and library books for schools in the North & South. We have donated Library books to schools in the North & East and constructed new classrooms in the south, provided filtering units for drinking water to villagers of Kebithigollewa. For most of these projects, we were able to obtain manpower from the Sri Lankan Armed Forces. These projects have enhanced the lives of the less fortunate. We were able to achieve this with the generosity of all of you who attend our Annual Royal Ball, for which I thank you very much.

I wish to thank the Executive Committee and their spouses for helping us to organize this event. We are fortunate to have Past Presidents who support our efforts, guide and encourage us all the time.

Last but not least, I would like to thank our sponsors, advertisers, the management and staff of the Royal Manor for making tonight's event a success.

#### TEENAGE ROYALIST GRANTED A BRITISH ROYAL PATENT 100 YEARS AGO "Bertram Elibank Dawapurarathna" (1895 – 1918)

This is a story of a child genius who shone brilliantly at Royal College, Colombo when the school was located at St. Sebastian Hill, Hulftsdorp and went on to develop a patent in England for improving steam engines in locomotives



**DAWAPURARATHNA IN 1912** 

**PATENT DESIGN** 

Bertram Elibank Dawapurarathna was the inventor of a mechanism that improved the Reversing Gear in Steam Engines. His original design was patented and registered in London in 1910 (patent no. 6883). He also had a second patent in 1913 for a device that improved the valve mechanism of internal combustion Engines.

After completing his studies at Royal College, he went to England to pursue higher studies in Mechanical Engineering at the University of Glasgow in 1912. He chose the University of Glasgow as this was where the famous mechanical engineer James Watt

developed improvements to the Steam engine, after whom the unit of power "Watt" was developed. Professor William Rankine who developed the complete theory of the steam engine and the "Rankine Cycle" also attended the University. Glasgow was also the home of the North British Locomotive Co, which was the largest locomotive manufacturer in Europe, and supplied many of the locomotives to the Ceylon Government Railway (CGR).

On March 20, 1913, a few months after Bertram commenced his engineering studies in Glasgow, he applied for a patent for "Improved Valve Mechanism for Internal Combustion Engines". He was granted Royal Patent No. 6883 exactly a year later on March 20, 1914.

The most commonly used valves in four stroked internal combustion engines are poppet valves. The minimum number of valves is two per cylinder (inlet & exhaust). Some high performance engines have more than the minimum number. Dawapurarathna's patent was a proposal to reduce the number of valves from four to two, for two cylinders. The two cylinder "A" and "B" (see Figure) have a common valve chamber "c" in which there is a rotating tapered plug valve "f" rotating at half the crankshaft speed. The air/fuel mixture from the carburetor enter from the top through the passage "h" and is admitted to the cylinders when the gap "g" is in line with the ports "a" and "b". Line up with the gap "k", the exhaust gases leave the cylinder through the passage "j" to the exhaust outlet "d". This was quite an ingenious idea to reduce the number of valves and cost of the engines.

It is said that during the war he was flying a test plane which crashed after which he returned to Colombo to convalesce in a warm climate. He went back to England and graduated as a mechanical engineer in 1917. He had embarked on a ship ' P & O Nyanza' to finally return to Ceylon. On the way the ship was attacked by a German Submarine and badly damaged within 25 miles off the shores of England. Both Bertram Dawapurarathna and another Ceylonese - Walter de Silva, were seriously injured and died in Hospital after they were taken back to England in the badly damaged ship. Available records reveal that Bertram Dawapurarathna had died in 1918, when he was 22 years old, and ashes interred in a British cemetery.

Had he lived a normal life span, he would without a doubt have been on par with the famous engineer D. J. Wimalasurendra who had the vision to conceive the Laxapana Hydro-Electric project about 100 years ago.

The RUMC NICU has enjoyed an excellent reputation for so long that it has established itself in the metropolitan region as a brand characterized by quality.

The exceptional outcomes are a result of Dr. Harin's tremendous commitment and dedication to the NICU. He relentlessly strived for technical and procedural perfection. If you did not meet his expectations, he would let you know it. His loyal staff has been trained so well that even when he was not there, his wishes were always put into place. If you were not sure, you could call him up — day or night, weekday or weekend. Another great passion of Dr. Harin was teaching and guiding the Pediatric residents. For the last few years, he has served as the coordinator of the Pediatric Department's program to teach and promote professionalism among the trainees.

Whether a patient's family could not pay or whether they could donate to the hospital, Dr. Harin's children were always treated the same.

For almost three decades, Staten Islanders have been very lucky to have such a wonderful resource so close by. They have one special man to thank for that, Dr. Anantham Harin. In these times, it is rare and particularly noteworthy when one individual can truly make such a significant difference for so many. Dr. Harin has impacted the entire borough by creating a special unit where his presence can be felt day and night, all year long. While his friendship and his leadership will be missed, his legacy lives on in his many success stories.
