
Whether a patient's family could not pay or whether they could donate to the hospital, *Dr. Harin's children were always treated the same.*

Dasis Manchanayake scored both a stunning century and half-century and then stunned the entire country by leading his team to a splendid victory over their rivals. This will remain etched in the memory of all those who were privileged to watch this unforgettable 144th Royal Thomian encounter.

However, there is another story equally interesting lurking in Dasis's background. The story of his closely-knit family.

His father Tissa, a gentle unassuming man was educated at the Veyangoda Central School. So too were his four brothers in a family of eight children. "Veyangoda Central College" also known as Bandaranayake Central College, Veyangoda, is a National school in Sri Lanka. Dasis loving mother Ms. Nilmini Manchanayake has written an endearing article published in this year's beautiful Royal Thomian souvenir (Royal College) under the caption ' The experiences of Cricket Captain's Mother'.

Dasis Kaveeja Manchanayake was born on October 08, 2003. His mother Nilmini says "Seeing this chubby and pretty boy for the first time was one of the happiest moments of my life. Later, when I was passing by Royal College and seeing the little boys dressed in blue shorts there, I was always telling my husband that we should try and get our son admitted to Royal College. It was one of my dreams then and I became so happy when I could fulfill my first dream for my son".

She further says that when his father, an ardent cricket lover was watching international cricket matches on television, Dasis used to join his father and many a time had tried to imitate world-class cricketers. His father Tissa used to encourage the little boy to play cricket even before he started schooling.

At the age of eight Dasis was selected for training at the Royal College Cricket Academy. There he progressed by leaps and bounds. Dasis was first selected to play in the 2020th Big Match at the age of fifteen and a half years and he validated the trust and confidence of the Selectors by displaying his remarkable hidden talent with a match-saving 53 runs not out which was the highest score for his side.

His father Tissa was the man behind the scene of Dasis's remarkable success in cricket. After years of sustained support to his son Dasis via a veritable balancing exercise of both work and play, Tissa had to finally give up his job in a leading Bank i.e., retiring prematurely, to enable him to devote full time to help his son to make progress in cricket.

The Manchanayake Family

The family comprises unassuming humble folk. They belong to the category of folk that uses public transport for travel, speak in the vernacular languages, read mainly indigenous i.e., Sinhala, language newspapers, interact humbly with others, and more importantly are rooted in patriotism and undivided loyalty to their country.

Here are some interesting details supplied by one of Dasis's close relatives i.e., an uncle.

Tissa Manchanayake had four brothers and three sisters altogether eight (8) in the family. His father (grandfather of Dasis) the late Subasinghe Manchanayake was a teacher who ended his career as the Principal of Magalegoda Maha Vidyalaya in Veyangoda.

Tissa is a Mechanical Engineer, a graduate of the Faculty of Engineering, University of Moratuwa, Katubedda Campus. He has worked on Mahaweli development projects, the Airport and finally ended up as the Area Manager (Transport) Peoples Bank in Mirigama (Watumulla).

Dasis's mother is a housewife. Dasis's sister is a student at the University of Moratuwa (Katubedda) There were no silver spoons in their mouths. Despite a lack of privilege at birth and upbringing they have broken through the glass ceiling and invisible barriers and made entry into the big picture. Dasis will take them higher as Sachin Tendulkar did in India. He is the 'Pin Putha'. A gift from the heavens. Dasis sensational achievements at the Royal Thomian constitute the stuff of dreams.

There were others in the team who gave a helping hand, especially fresher Ramiru Perera who together with Dasis broke the Royal Thomian 5th wicket partnership record with aplomb. A graceful 229-run partnership. Ramiru scored 128 runs in the first innings and an unbeaten 46 runs in the second innings falling four runs short of emulating Dasis who scored a century (137) and half-century (57), being the first Captain to do so. Ramiru is a smart 15-year-old lad with a world to conquer in the future.

Dasis bats like Arjuna Ranatunga. An attacking left-handed batsman who can put to flight any savage bowling attack on his day. Remember Sanath Jayasuriya, Pathum Nissanka, and a host of others with origins outside the metropolis in the last 30 years or so who have taken Sri Lanka to unbelievable heights in World Cricket.

Dasis is in that mould. He has spoken with the bat and the ball and captured our hearts. The World salutes true heroes, not artificial ones. Sri Lanka needs heroes desperately - for every generation. Role models inspire others within and outside the playing field. Cricket needs not only the brawn but also the brains i.e., 'Cricket thinkers', even beyond the boundary line. This is the new vision that must guide the SLC.

Now the last question. Who should be allocated credit for this massive turnaround in the fortunes of ordinary folk now trying their luck in cricket?

The answer is not blowing in the wind.

Free education introduced by the Minister of Education C.W.W. Kannangara in the pre-independence era and the 1956 Bandaranaike Revolution of the Common Man were the turning points.

' The Panas Haye Daruwo' (children of 1956) using the sobriquet coined by the writer Nalin de Silva, is now turning tables in almost every aspect of life in Sri Lanka.

Cricket is uniting people in a way (irrespective of their social backgrounds), unimaginable decades ago, Cricket has brought even the most politically irreconcilable parties together.

We should all be happy about these changes.

Outside the Ropes By Chanaka De Silva

Nostalgia like vintage wine matures and tastes better with time. The ones who remember and relate these stories, of those halcyon days, usually adapt new twists and adds rapturous details to the old tales each New Year. Royal-Thomian time is when the narrator becomes the center of attraction. He would, with abundant clarity, recount fresh adaptations and new sequels of the real thing, with the customary preamble "Machang, you remember when that mad b......er got caught toetc.etc?"

Memories are fading, but when I was asked by an old college friend's son to write for the Royal-Thomian Souvenir, memories came flashing back of what went on outside the ropes than those within. The Royal-Thomian, in those days (60's) were, the very very core of school life. Come the Ides-of-March or thereabouts, a complete transformation takes place at school. Everything else takes second place and even revered teachers, held in great respect and fear for most part of the year of, mellow like all of us, to the revelry of this short period.

I was a Hosteller from the 1st to the 5th form, although my parents lived not far from school. Perhaps, I was enjoying myself too much at home, or under playing the importance of studies, that my father in his infinite wisdom thought, his son would do much better if he turned out from the hostel, rather than home. It was not to be the case, as you shall see.

It was around Royal-Thomian time that I obtained an "exeat" to retreat home for the weekend, but in reality, to spend the weekend with a friend, another hosteller, in good preparation for the big match. We had a ball that weekend, and I turned up at the Hostel a day late, on Monday night, rather that the usual Sunday night. I had a letter of excuse ready for the Warden C.E.Belleth, who as a custom took our studies each morning. Mr.Belleth was a firm and devoutly religious person who prayed to God each evening and who vainly tried to spiritually uplift us hostellers, under him. "De Silva, where were you yesterday?" he bellowed. "Sir, I was not well." I said. "You got a letter of excuse,? "Yes Sir" I replied handing over the letter, which I wrote myself on behalf of an unsuspecting father. That evening I was called up to his quarters, asked to bend over, only to receive 6 of the best. I hadn't a clue as to why this cruel assault on my buttocks was for. Another Hosteller who was in the sick room located right below Mr.Belleth's quarters heard him pray late that evening to God "Please God, make sure that De.Silva gets his spelling right next rime-F-L-U is not spelt, F-L-E-W", he told God. It was the year 1962, when I had finished playing Cricket for college. Desmond Fernando & I were appointed as Royal-Thomian Tent secretaries while Padde Witharana was the Treasurer. We were the most senior Prefects at School. On the first day of the match (in those days, Royal Thomian was played over 2 days) before the match could start, we had most unfortunately consumed a few beer's and were not found to be around. True to form, after the match we were all reported by another Prefect to the Principal, Mr. Dudley K.G.De Silva, of having been found smelling of Beer even before the start of play. We were hauled up before Dudley, but with vanished spirits. and fermented mind we deftly denied the charges. We thought the matter would rest there. But, our Principal with great fore-thought wrote out a questionnaire which was distributed amongst all Stewards and the 4 Masters in charge of the tent. About 60 in, all for prompt reply.

The questions (& answers by all except 2 stewards' went something like this:-

- Did you see Fernando De Silva & Witharne at 12.05 p.m.:-Yes, Sir.
- Did you happen to find any of them under the influence of alcohol?-No, Sir.
- Did you happen to speak to any of them? Yes, Sir.
- Were any of them sleeping in the tent, at any time? No, Sir.

Did they smell of Alcoho?-Not at all, Sir.

With 58 out of the 60 answers in hand in exactly the way Dudley had planned, he called up the Prefect who reported us and admonished him thoroughly for telling lies. He was warned and discharged with a last warning for making a false complaint. That Prefect later came to be a Minister of the State!

Then, there was a colleague who later rose to the highest position in the Judicial Service Commission, who missed an entire Royal-Thomian as he was lying flat in a lorry hired for the precession. He had imbibed one too many before the match!

Another colleague was doubling his friend home on his push bicycle around 07.30 p.m. after the match on Galle Road. He had no head Lamp, either. A Policeman who was on duty on the pavement jumped on to stop. 'Sorry', my friend shouted, I have no breaks to stop and continued his journey chased by the cop. This guy too ended up as the Hon. Minister of the State. Many other tales come to mind which will keep you in fits of laughter. But time and space do not permit me to relate more of these gems.

The final year I plated (1962) was a most interesting Royal-Thomian Darrel Lieversz, our captain & I had waded through almost the entirety of the other school sides that year. St. Peter's twice, for 30 and 44. Ananda for 70 in the second innings St. Benedicts for 89 in the 1st Innings, St. Anthonys for 76 in the 1st Innings, St. Josephs for 75 in the 1st Innings, Nalanda for 69 Trinity for 43 & St. Thomas for 83 in the 2nd Innings etc. Between us we had taken over 112 wickets for the season. This could well be an all school record. It was easy for me as the other opening bowler to Darrel, who was one of the finest in-swingers (as well as a gentleman) of all-time. Most batsmen feared Darrel so much that they went for their strokes against me and I picked up many wickets, as a result.

The Royal-Thomian of that year was one that we could have won. We had 11 runs to make with 3 wickets to go and plenty of time to make it. It ended in a draw. Trevor Janson has been tormented for the rest of his life for holding on rather than going for it. But that is, from all those who don't know the real story. Trecor was only carrying out instructions! Trevor, is a leading Surgeon in Adelaide, Australia and to-date, takes a barrage of insults from friends and fore, for playing for a draw, But yet remains tightlipped in solemn defense of this instructor. There was magic within the ropes too. Jothilingam's 121 in 1956, Ronnie Reid's 156 the same year and his 2x65's in the next, Vijaya Malalasejera;s terrific 106 in 1962, comes to mind. We were all molded into men in the field by the likes of Mahesh Rodrigo, the late Christie Gunasekera and the late Sunith Goonethileke. Whilst our teachers made us "learn of books and men" these gentlemen of the field taught us "how to play the game". We still do.

Somebody asked me the other day, which period of your life do you consider your happiest? There is only one answer. It is obvious.


