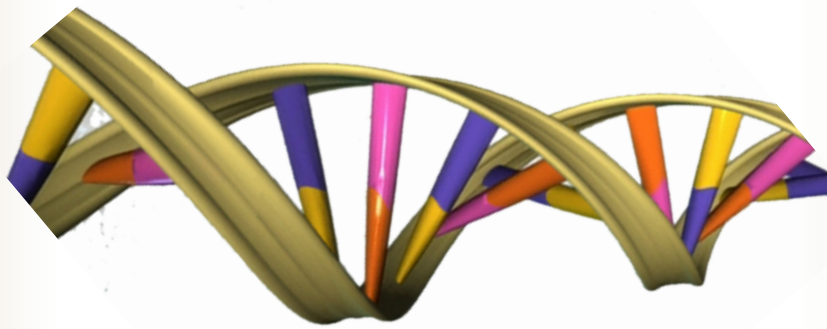

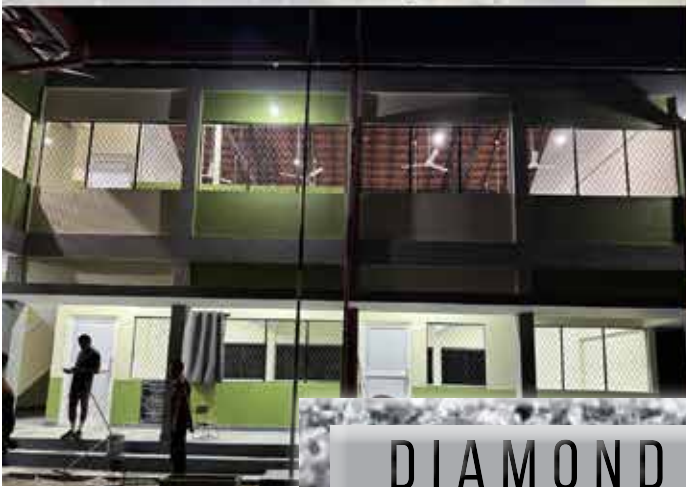

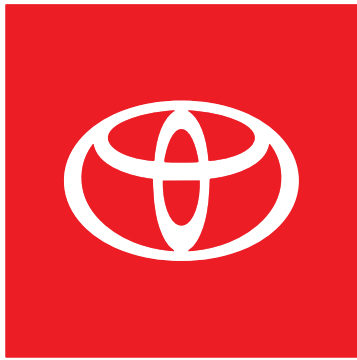

Anantham Harin, M.D.

Dr. Anantham Harin had been with Richmond University Medical Center for nearly 30 years as the Director of the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU). About one fifth of all of our newborns will go through the NICU, including the smallest, sickest and frailest of this borough's citizens.



In any schoolyard, Little League game, football game, classroom, church, Girl and Boy Scout troop, there are those children (and their parents) who have benefited directly from Dr. Harin, or have a cousin, neighbor, teammate or classmate who has.

Under Dr. Harin's guidance, the NICU was not only one of the original participants in the nationwide registry of NICU's, but our borough's premier NICU has outcomes scores that place it among the elite centers for many of the common neonatal programs in the country. Overall, while the national NICU mortality ranges from 4-5 per 1,000 admissions, at RUMC, the rate has been consistently lower. The RUMC NICU has enjoyed an excellent reputation for so long that it has established itself in the metropolitan region as a brand characterized by quality.

The exceptional outcomes are a result of Dr. Harin's tremendous commitment and dedication to the NICU. He relentlessly strived for technical and procedural perfection. If you did not meet his expectations, he would let you know it. His loyal staff has been trained so well that even when he was not there, his wishes were always put into place. If you were not sure, you could call him up – day or night, weekday or weekend. Another great passion of Dr. Harin was teaching and guiding the Pediatric residents. For the last few years, he has served as the coordinator of the Pediatric Department's program to teach and promote professionalism among the trainees.

Whether a patient's family could not pay or whether they could donate to the hospital, Dr. Harin's children were always treated the same.

For almost three decades, Staten Islanders have been very lucky to have such a wonderful resource so close by. They have one special man to thank for that, Dr. Anantham Harin. In these times, it is rare and particularly noteworthy when one individual can truly make such a significant difference for so many. Dr. Harin has impacted the entire borough by creating a special unit where his presence can be felt day and night, all year long. While his friendship and his leadership will be missed, his legacy lives on in his many success stories.

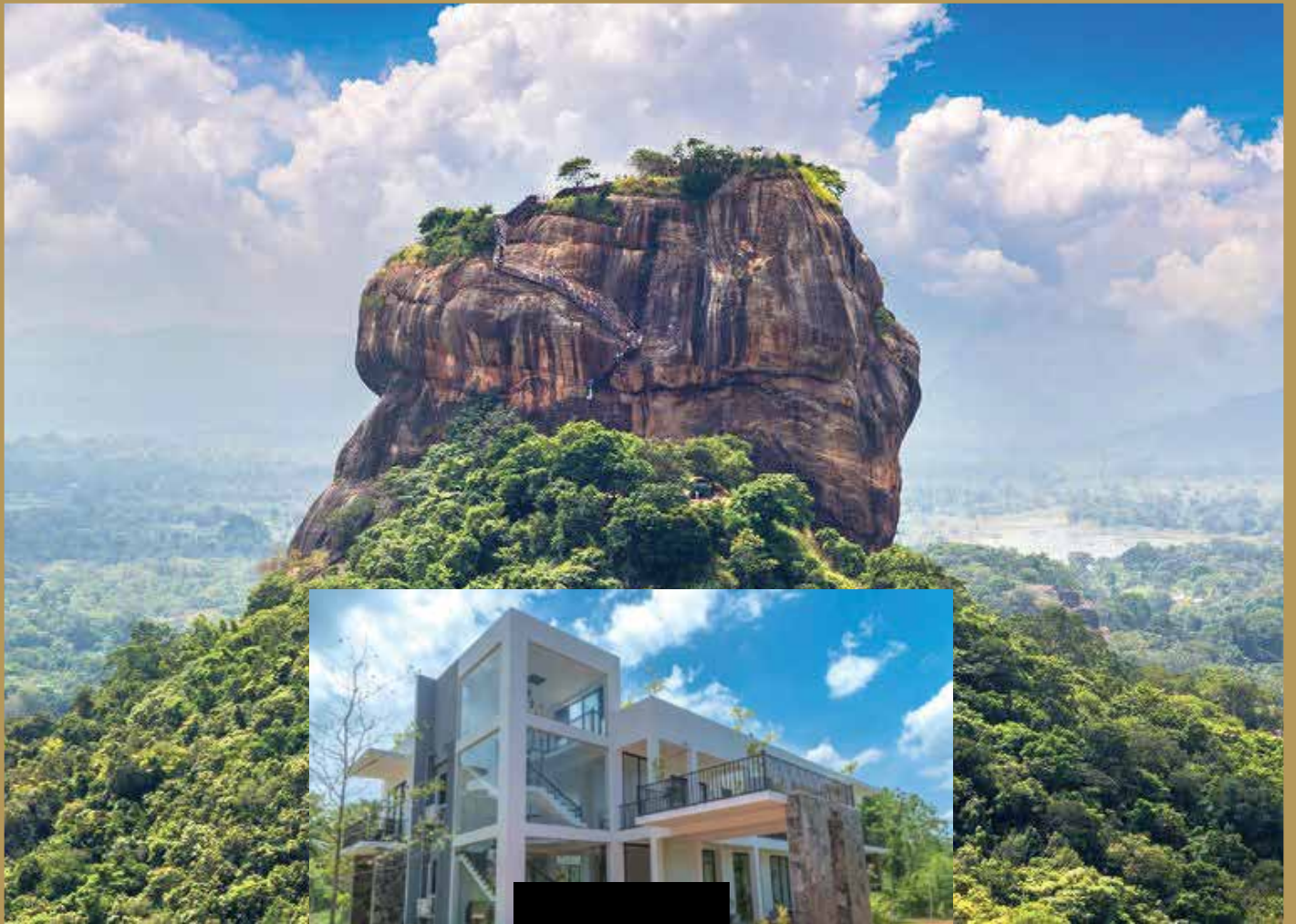

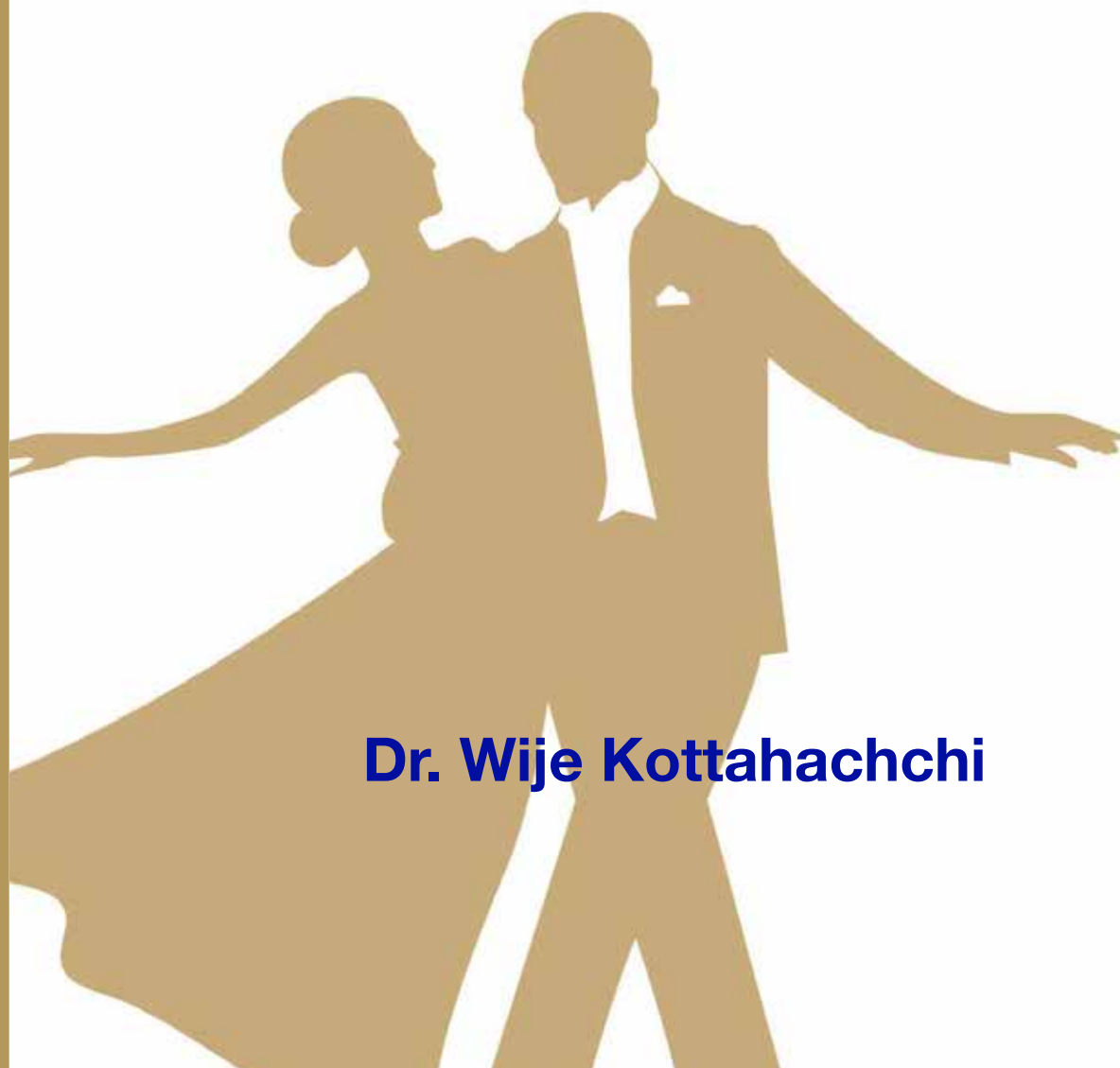

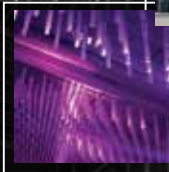

Your generosity at our event played a significant role in the success of this initiative, and we are pleased to inform you that this event raised close to **Rs. 4 million**.



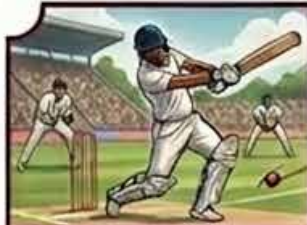

My journey at Royal (RIYAZ ALUHER)

(Old Royalist, Former Assistant Principal & Senior Games Master)

My journey with Royal College Colombo began in 1986, when I was fortunate to gain admission through both the entrance and scholarship examinations. That moment marked the beginning of a lifelong association with an institution that has profoundly shaped my character, values, and outlook on life.

From Grade 6 to Grade 13, I pursued my education in the Tamil medium. During my Advanced Level years, I had the opportunity to study alongside Sinhala medium students as well. This integration created a diverse and enriching environment, fostering friendships across communities and strengthening mutual respect—an experience that remains invaluable to me.

As a student, I was primarily focused on academics, while also participating in football at a modest level. I had the privilege of serving as an editor of several school clubs, which helped refine my leadership and communication skills. My proficiency in all three languages is something I deeply owe to my parents and the dedicated teachers who guided me throughout my school years.

I come from a family rooted in education. My parents are retired government teachers who instilled in me discipline and a passion for learning. My brother, also a Royalist, is now a consultant nutritionist in the United Kingdom, while my sister is a Chemistry teacher who graduated from the Open University.

Upon leaving school, I explored opportunities to pursue medicine locally and abroad, as per my parents' wishes. However, when those avenues did not materialise, I chose teaching—a decision that became my life's calling.

I trained as an English Language teacher at the Bolawalana Teachers' Training College and received my first appointment at Welithara Muslim Maha Vidyalaya. For eight years, I travelled daily from Mount Lavinia to Balapitiya, a journey that demanded dedication and perseverance.

I then served for ten years at St. Mary's College Dehiwala before returning to my alma mater. Spending 13 years at Royal College as a teacher and later as an administrator was both an honour and a privilege. Today, having completed 30 years in the field of education, I continue to contribute as a consultant while supporting the College in every possible way.

During my tenure at Royal, I began as a classroom teacher, later taking charge of football, and eventually serving as Assistant Principal and Senior Games Master. In this capacity, I was entrusted with overseeing 50 clubs and societies, along with 35 sports disciplines, including cadeting and scouting. These responsibilities were demanding yet deeply fulfilling.

I also had the opportunity to serve under seven Principals, extending my fullest support to each of them. While changes in leadership and evolving policies—particularly the transfer of experienced teachers—presented challenges, Royal College consistently maintained its excellence in both academic and extracurricular spheres.

How Royal Remains Royal:

Despite the many challenges faced over the years, Royal College continues to uphold its identity and standards.

There have been concerns expressed regarding a perceived decline in the number of students from the Old Boys' community entering the College. While such observations may hold some truth, it is important to understand the broader context behind this shift.

One major factor is the increasing trend of migration. The global phenomenon of brain drain has led many families to seek better opportunities abroad, often choosing to educate their children overseas.

Additionally, even within Sri Lanka, changing global dynamics have influenced educational preferences. Many parents now opt for international curricula such as the London or Cambridge syllabi, which are not available in government schools. This has naturally impacted enrolment patterns.

Another contributing factor is the medium of instruction. Government schools primarily offer Sinhala and Tamil medium education at the primary level, whereas a growing number of parents prefer English medium education from the very beginning of their children's schooling. This shift has also played a role in shaping current trends.

However, despite these changes, Royal College remains steadfast in its core values and identity.

Its strength lies not merely in numbers, but in its enduring culture of excellence, discipline, and unity.

A Truly Secular Institution:

One of the most defining features of Royal College is its secular character.

The College has always provided space and respect for all religions, fostering an environment of inclusivity and mutual understanding. While there have been occasional discussions in recent times, such matters have been addressed with maturity and responsibility.

Royal continues to stand as a place where diversity is respected and unity is preserved—just as it has always been.

The support of the Old Royalists' Associations, both locally and globally, remains a cornerstone of the College's success. Their contributions have ensured that Royal continues to thrive and maintain its high standards.

As an Assistant Principal and Senior Games Master, I had the honour of accompanying national-winning teams abroad on several occasions, providing students with invaluable exposure. I was also privileged to be invited to the United Kingdom in 2023 by the Old Royalists' Association UK.

In addition, I would like to place on record my sincere appreciation to ROCOBANA for felicitating my visit to California last year, during my participation in the Counselor Connect Programme organised by the United States education authorities. Their warm reception and recognition were truly meaningful and memorable.

This year, I am once again honoured to attend the ROCOBEC Foundation Ball through your kind invitation. I extend my sincere appreciation to the past presidents, the present president, secretary, committee members, and all those who made this possible.

The contributions of the ROCOBEC Foundation during my tenure have been remarkable and far-reaching. In addition to their many impactful initiatives, I would like to highlight:

- Construction of the Nagendran Tennis Complex
- Construction of the gymnasium at the Swimming Pool Complex
- The felicitation of Royal–Thomian winning cricket and tennis teams
- Assistance extended to the chess team that recently toured the United States
- Assistance extended to Flood Victims affected by Hurricane Ditwah in Sri Lanka

RCOBECF lost a dear friend and long-term supporter, Cecil Fernando - affectionately known throughout the Sri Lankan community as "Trumpet Cecil" — in 2025. For many years, Cecil was an integral part of RCOBECF's Annual Events, gracing every occasion with his masterful command of the trumpet and saxophone.

Born in Sri Lanka in 1955, Cecil came to the United States in 1986 with a dream of building a new life for his family. Wherever he went, he carried with him a natural charisma, a deep love for those closest to him, and an enduring passion for music that never dimmed.

Music was the heartbeat of Cecil's life. A true multi-instrumentalist, he mastered the trumpet, saxophone, mellophone, and trombone, and even taught himself piano. In Sri Lanka, he performed with the Army Band, Superstars, and Talk of the Town - celebrated ensembles that

showcased his extraordinary talent. In the United States, his performances spanned the country, becoming woven into the fabric of cherished memories for countless families. He was a beloved fixture at Royal College events, Sri Lankan Medical Association of North America dances, the Ananda College Cricket Festival, and many other community gatherings.

In 2005, Cecil embarked on a new chapter, forming his own one-man band. His performances brought joy to friends, neighbors, and fellow community members, allowing him to keep doing what he loved well into his later years. For decades, he also played trumpet in multiple church choirs and remained an active, warmly regarded member of the Sri Lankan Catholic community, known as much for his generosity and warmth as for his remarkable gift.

In a fitting tribute, RCOBECF hosted a farewell dinner for Cecil and his family in his final months, presenting him with a digital photo frame filled with memories from his many Royal College performances — a moment that captured everything he meant to this community.

Cecil's legacy lives on in every note he played and in the hearts of all who knew and loved him. He was a true friend to many — and the music never stops for those he leaves behind.
